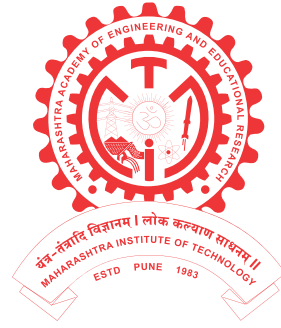
The Statutes and Ordinance of the university are published in the "Madhya Pradesh Gazette No. R-414/CC/2017/38", dated 22nd September 2017.

The Avantika Curriculum

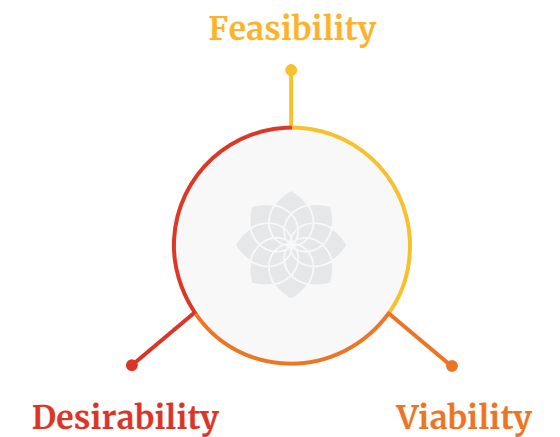


The Avantika Curriculum is based on the premise that

Project Based Learning

Project Based Learning allows students to gain knowledge and skills by working for an extended period to investigate and respond to an engaging and complex question, problem, or challenge.

5 keys to rigorous problem solving

- Real World Connection- Authentic Problem
- Effective Learning - Through the Project
- Structured Collaboration
- Student Driven: Teachers become facilitators, and students take control. As facilitators, teachers need to ask good questions and redirect the students, if necessary.
- Multifaceted Assessment – This includes in-between assessment and formative assessments. Students should also be able to assess themselves.

Experiential Learning

Experiential Learning is a process through which students develop knowledge, skills, and values from direct experiences outside a traditional academic setting.

Experiential Learning follows a process of

- ACT (Concrete Experience)
- APPLY (Reflexive Observation)
- REFLECT (Abstract Conceptualisation)
- CONCEPTUALIZE (Practical Application)

Activity Based Learning

Activity Based Learning (ABL) is a subset of Experiential Learning where students learn at their own pace through teacher-facilitated exercises.

The core premise of ABL is based on doing some hands-on experiments and activities. The idea of ABL is rooted in the common notion that students are active learners rather than passive recipients of information. If they are provided the opportunity to explore on their own along with an optimum learning environment, then the learning becomes joyful and long-lasting.

Blended Learning

Blended Learning is an education program (formal or informal) that combines online digital media with traditional classroom methods. It requires the physical presence of both teacher and student, with some element of student control over time, place, path, or pace.

While students still attend “brick-and-mortar” schools with a teacher present, face-to-face classroom practices are combined with computer-mediated activities regarding content and delivery. Blended Learning is also used in professional development and training settings.

Flipped Classroom

The Flipped Classroom is a pedagogical model in which the typical lecture and homework elements of a course are reversed. Short video lectures are viewed by students at home before the class session, while in-class time is devoted to exercises, projects, or discussions. The video lecture is often seen as the key ingredient in the flipped approach, such lectures being either created by the instructor and posted online or selected from an online repository.

While a pre-recorded lecture could certainly be a podcast or other audio format, the ease with which video can be accessed and viewed today has made it so ubiquitous that the flipped model has come to be identified with it.

Scenerio Based Learning /Contextual Learning

Scenario Based Learning (SBL) uses interactive scenarios to support active learning strategies such as problem-based or case-based learning. It normally involves students working their way through a storyline, usually based around an ill-structured or complex problem, which they are required to solve.

Storytelling

Storytelling is an activity that can transfer emotions and feelings, and also can boost thinking capacity. It involves the conveying of events in words, sound and/or images, often by improvisation or embellishment. Stories or narratives have been shared in every culture as a means of entertainment, education, cultural preservation, and instilling moral values. Storytelling is an art that has mental, social and educational benefits for students

Play

Learning through play is a term used in education and psychology to describe how a student can learn to make sense of the world around them. Through play, students can develop social and cognitive skills, mature emotionally, and gain the self-confidence required to engage in new experiences and environments.

Key ways that young students learn include playing, being with other people, being active, exploring new experiences, talking to themselves, communication with others, meeting physical and mental challenges, being shown how to do new things, practicing and repeating skills and having fun.

Game and Game Design

Game Design is the art of applying design and aesthetics to create a game to facilitate interaction between players for playful, healthful, educational, or simulation purposes. Game Design can be applied both to games and to other interactions, particularly virtual ones.

Foundation Year

The Foundation Program is a unique and exclusive feature built on the philosophy of liberal education. It provides an opportunity to broaden the perspective of learning by creative thinking and experimentation. Being a common program for students of all streams, it aims at building the creative, analytical, social and individual skills required to excel in the chosen fields. There are also a set of distinct courses for all the domains which aim at building skills deemed essential for the core courses which are selected in the succeeding year.

The students work on a wide variety of projects, indulge in social and industry immersions, and understand the entrepreneurial spirit through various industry connect activities. This exposure creates a platform to learn and grow which in turn facilitates the selection of desired fields at the end of the program.

The Foundation Program is considered to be the most crucial part of these professional courses. It gives students the freedom to ideate and develop the skill of creative problem-solving. The learners extensively explore, collaborate, create and are continuously assessed by domain-leaders who let them carve their own journey through expert guidance and ice-breaking sessions.

ASSESSMENT

Assessment at Avantika is based on the performance of the student as a process, and not as an event

The performance of a student in a course is assessed through a series of Continuous Assessment (CA) Components and Course End Assessment (CEA), as per the requirements and nature of individual courses.

The assessment may consist of closed book or open book examination, quizzes, portfolio generation, assignments, problem solving, programming, prototyping, field work, projects, or any other innovative assessment practices followed by the faculty.

The Course End Assessment is in the form of an external Jury.

The assessment criteria lays 80% weightage on continuous assessment and 20% on Jury which forms a letter grade in individual courses leading to a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) on a scale of 10.

At Avantika, the faculty members act as facilitators and co-learners to create a learner-centered environment

With practical-based learning spread across all programs, the workshop acts as the central point of students' academic indulgence giving shape to their projects. The various shops boast of state-of-the-art machinery and skilled manpower support making it one of its kind precinct for varied spheres of design, manufacturing and fabrication.



FAB Lab

The FAB Lab at Avantika is a state-of-the-art lab consisting of high-end digital fabrication and manufacturing machinery consisting of an array of flexible computer-controlled tools, that cover several different length scales and various materials, with the aim to make “almost anything” and cater a platform for new ideas and innovation.

Wood Shop



The Wood Shop is a place where the students explore the fundamentals of woodwork and carpentry getting deep insight into the use of Timber. Students make use of hand and power tools to develop various joineries and products by performing planning, sawing and chiselling operations. The Wood Shop includes Wood Lathe, Band Saw, Jig Saw, Single Bevel Mitre, Surface Planer Cum Thickness Wood Planer.

Metal Shop



The Metal Shop is a place where the students explore working with metal to design, develop and fabricate various products through operations like Cylindrical Turning, Step Turning, Taper Turning, Facing, Cutting, Milling, Chamfering, Drilling, Reaming. The Metal Shop includes Lathe Machine, Milling Machine, Drilling Machine, Bench Grinder, Pipe Bending Machine, Metal Cutter 1100W, Metal Shear 1.6, Nibbler 1.6, and Kit of Forming tools etc.

Welding Shop



Welding Shop is a place where the students perform arc welding fusion processes for joining metals. The different operations practiced by students in Welding Shop are Position Welding, Butt Welding, Lap Welding, Spot Welding, etc. The Welding Shop includes ARC+ Tig Welding Machine with safety equipments.

Fitting Shop



The Fitting Shop is a place where the students refine their products to achieve desired shapes, size and accuracy, through various finishing operations such as marking, filing, chipping, sawing, scraping, drilling, reaming, tapping, threading and grinding etc. The Fitting Shop includes, Machine Vice, Bench and Hand Drill Machine, Angle Grinder 540W with Angle Polisher Attachment, and various files etc.

Plastic Shop



Plastic Shop is a place where students learn to turn plastic into permanent objects such as protective covers by identifying and acquainting with suitable materials. Students learn to design wood, machined aluminum molds, which are used to develop different shapes with the use of vacuum forming machines.

Paint Shop



The Paint Shop is a place where students give surface treatment to their prototypes or models with the aim to give a final finish to their products. Students work with water and solvent-based paints, varnishes, various surface treatment agents, oils and waxes for this process using paint spraying booths.

Cashless Campus

All transactions at Avantika are done through its Campus Wallet. Code of Conduct

When you register to become a student of Avantika University, it is implicit that you agree and accept the University's standards of academic and social integrity.

Standards of Academic and Social Integrity at Avantika

Prohibited and restricted conduct at Avantika includes the following:

- Any unlawful alterations in academic assignments, records and documents or forging signatures of authorization or falsifying information on official academic documents, viewing or altering computer records, or modifying computer programs or systems.
- Consumption or possession of alcohol, illegal drugs, and smoking on campus.
- Possession of dangerous weapons.
- Disruption of teaching, learning, administration, research, hearing procedures, or any other activities of the University.
- Damaging University property, stealing, destroying, defacing, or concealing library materials/academic tools with the intention of depriving other students from using them.
- Providing deliberate assistance/abetment in any prohibitory behavior as stated above will also result in punitive action.

Anti Ragging Policy

Hostel Rules

- Use water and electricity prudently and avoid wastage.
- In cases of any unforeseen event or incidents of disturbance, students are requested to immediately contact their respective warden.
- Use of any electrical appliances other than the room fixtures is strictly prohibited.
- At the end of the academic year, the student shall hand over the charge of his/ her room with all furniture and fixtures to the hostel warden.
- Students shall maintain decorum and dignity, and shall not create any nuisance.
- Consumption of alcohol, restricted drugs or smoking, is strictly prohibited within campus.
- **Avantika University is a fully vegetarian campus** and consumption of non-vegetarian food inside the campus is strictly prohibited, non-negotiable and punishable under the laws of the university.
- Students are not allowed to go outside the campus from 8:00 pm to 6:00 am.
- Students going outside the campus have to obtain prior permission from their parents/ guardians. The duly signed permission form has to be handed over to the Warden at least 24 hours before leaving campus.

Disciplinary Procedures and Rules

Appeal and Hearing Process (AHP) at Avantika University

All alleged violations of rules and regulations of the university would be resolved by this process. The implementation may vary from case to case, and depend on the severity and intensity of the violation. The process consists of the following steps:

- Report of the event/ activity to the grievance cell.
- Preparation of initial enquiry report by grievance cell.
- Depending on the initial enquiry, the university or reporter may decide to resolve the issue by informal counseling of member(s) involved.
- In some cases, the university may recommend a grievance committee hearing process with both parties.

Confidentiality

Avantika University understands and respects individual rights. All aspects of AHP are maintained private and all participants (reporter and respondent), and members of the investigation and hearing committee in an AHP will be informed that confidentiality should be strictly followed in order to enhance the integrity of the investigation.

Students Rights

- Students' private information will not be shared or released to persons outside the university, without prior permission of students.
- Students will be consulted by or represented on university committees and their views will be considered for the welfare policy of the university.
- Students have freedom of speech to express their ideas, and may give alternate opinions to classroom discussions.
- There will be no discrimination based on race, color, ethnicity, religion, age, caste, creed, ancestry, sex, gender, disability, civil union status, or national origin.

Harsiddhi Temple

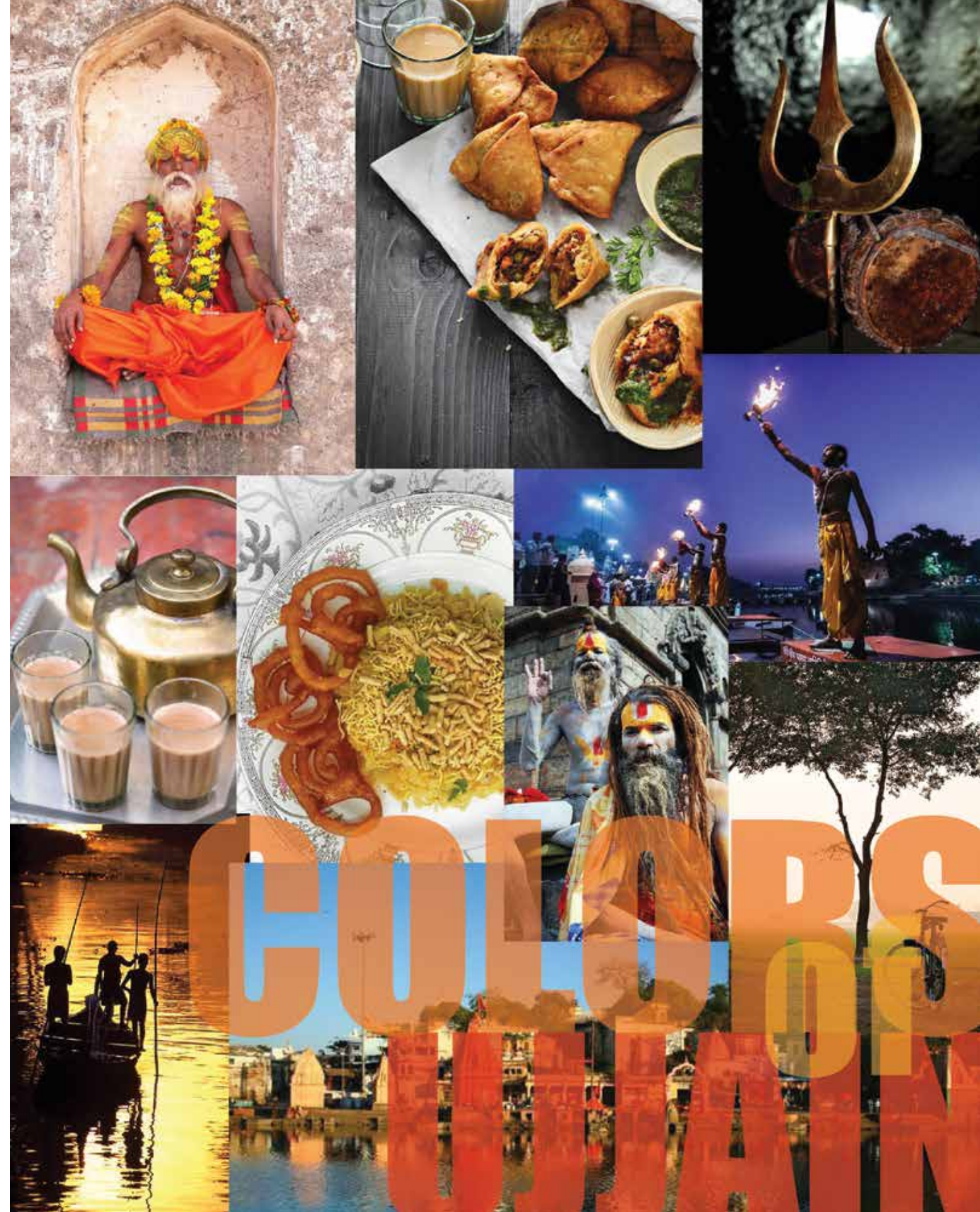
Built in the Maratha period, the temple has a special place in the city's history.

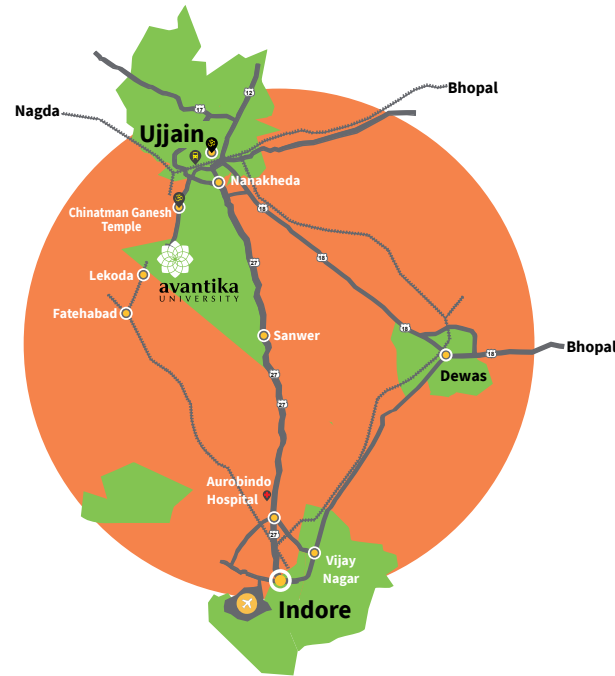
The closest airport is Devi Ahilyabai Holkar Domestic Airport at Indore. The busiest airport in Madhya Pradesh, it is well connected to most major Indian cities. The University is 55 km (34 miles) from the Indore Airport.



The railway stations at Ujjain and Indore have direct connectivity of trains from Delhi, Mumbai and other major cities of India. The railway station at Ujjain is 14 km (8 miles) from the campus, and the one at Indore is 50 km (31 miles) from the campus.
